Project Description	<p>The construction of a roller compacted concrete “RCC” flood control dam on the North Para River located 7km northeast of the township of Gawler. The project consisted of the following main elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provision of temporary works including site access, upstream & downstream coffer dams with piped river diversion & onsite concrete batch plant. • Excavation to rock foundation over dam footprint including detailed dental treatment. • Construction of the main RCC dam structure being 200m in length by 32m high, requiring the batching and placement of 45,000m³ of RCC. • Deployment of innovative jump formwork system for sheer upstream face and stepped downstream. • Integrated secondary spillway structure also with RCC and various misc metalwork structures including debris frame, access ladders and handrails.
